

Sample Letters of Intent to Marry

Templates for the petitioner's and beneficiary's statements of intent to marry within 90 days of arrival

A letter of intent to marry is a signed statement confirming that both parties are legally able and willing to marry each other within 90 days of the beneficiary's arrival in the United States on the K-1 visa. Both the petitioner and the beneficiary should each sign their own letter. These letters are typically included with the I-129F petition. Sample templates for both are provided below.
